### This Week

This week we thought about our school trip to Maidstone Museum and we wrote down some questions we wanted to find out the answers to when we visited. We loved the Museum and explored fossils which we were allowed to look at and do crayon rubbings of. We also walked around the Museum and went to the Dinosaur area where we saw real bone fossils! In Maths we measured the length of dinosaurs and explored using a ruler, using the language of more and less to compare lengths.
