This week's learning

This week we have been writing poems about the Great Fire of London. We made senses word mats to support us with these, we thought about what we might have been able to see, hear, smell and feel during the Great Fire of London. We then wrote a senses poem and an acrostic poem using this information. We have been working hard to ensure we are spelling common words correctly in our writing.

In Maths we have been looking at tens and ones and showing them pictorially. We have looked at numbers to 30. The children have been using manipulatives and drawings to show how many tens and ones are in a number.

We have also been counting in 2s to 24. We have identified that the numbers in the 2 times table are all even.

In Topic we have used pastels to create fire pictures, we then added our silhouettes to these and used tissue paper to create flames, the pictures look very effective.

In Science we have been looking at the weather, we have named different types of weather and thought about the items of clothing you would wear at various times of the year.
