## This week's learning

This week we have been looking at instructions. We have read instructions and looked at the key features of them and when they are used. We have followed instructions, we made Great Fire of London cakes. Following this we wrote our own instructions, making sure they included numbers and verbs. The children have been great at thinking of different verbs and including them in sentences.

In Maths we have been looking at multiplication, we have looked at the 'x' sign and the words 'lots of'. The children have used manipulatives to find 5 lots of 2 for example. They have also recorded their findings using basic arrays. The children have been counting in 2s and 10s this week, please continue to do this at home. 2s to 24 and 10s to 100 forwards and backwards.

In Topic we have followed instructions to make Great Fire of London cakes.

In Science we have looked at the seasons and the months of the year. The children have looked at events that take place in each season and the months of the year that take place in each season.

In computing we have used '2 Paint a Picture' to draw Fire engines.

We have been practising our Christmas play also.
