We had a great Christmas meal which included singing and dancing and lots of eating!



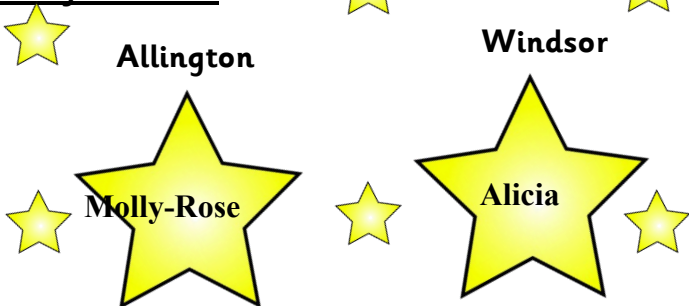
Home Learning
