In School Learning:

English: We are currently using the book 'Here we Are' by Oliver Jeffers to help us with our English. We have written in first person about how we feel coming back to school, we have thought about what makes our world wonderful and tried to use some rhyming words. This week, we will be making posters to inform people about why they should stay healthy and how they can do this. We will also be sequencing the story and writing about it using adjectives.
