KENT TEST

If you are a **Year 5** parent/carer, please be aware that for your child to sit the Kent Test in the autumn term 2021, you will need to register with KCC between 1st June and 1st July 2021. The link has not been uploaded yet, but please see the statement from KCC's website below:

September 2022 Secondary Admissions

You can register for the Kent Test between 1 June 2021 and 1 July 2021.

We will continue to monitor whether any adjustments are required to the Kent Test process this year in light of COVID-19. Please register as usual if you would like your child to be considered for a place at Kent grammar school in September 2022. The Kent Test is due to be held on the 9 September 2021 for children who go to a school in Kent and the 11 September 2021 for children who go to school outside of Kent.

If we need to make any changes to the Kent Test process in light of COVID-19, we will update these pages and contact everyone who has registered a child to take part.
