Swimming Contributions	Although swimming is a curriculum requirement, the significant price increase from the leisure centre and coach company were unexpected. No additional school funding is provided for either the lessons or the travel. In September, the leisure centre informed us of an imposed increased session time of 45 minutes. We have contacted other centres/hotels/gyms but unfortunately have been unsuccessful in gaining alternative provision. Mote Park remains the only viable option.
	The cost of coach travel has also increased due to fuel rises.

Brunswick House Primary School	The overall costs for swimming lessons this year are detailed below:-
	<ul> <li>Charges from Maidstone Leisure Centre £12,240</li> <li>Cost of travel to swimming £5,760</li> </ul>
	Coach travel will be taken from the school budget.
	This has resulted in a rise in contributions per student for swimming to $\pounds 8.50$ per week.
	In response to this, we may have to reassess our improvement plans as without contributions from parents to support us, we may have to reduce existing resources that children have access to this year.
	Parents' contributions towards these lessons are greatly appreciated and we understand that in the current financial climate, this may be difficult. Therefore, payment plans are offered to spread the payments out in smaller amounts.
Uniform	A draft Uniform Policy was sent out to parents for a consultation period and we have had those results back. There were a few queries on the term cobalt blue and royal blue. Cobalt blue was included as this is the colour name that some supermarkets use.
	We <b>do not</b> insist on logo items.
	We have allowed black tracksuit bottoms as well as navy.
	Preloved uniform items will be given away once a term after school.
	Uniform items can be worn all year round.
	A few families were concerned about the children leaving their PE kits at school, but we have reassured those parents that trainers can be taken home at weekends or during the week after PE days.
	There will be a disclaimer at the end of the uniform policy about prices being correct at time of printing but subject to change.
Parking	Mrs Bingham our year 2 rep, is a link police officer for MGGS and Maplesden Noakes. She has sent us information on parking on zig zags etc outside our school – this will be parent mailed out to families.
	A tenant at Brennan Mews has complained about a repeat offender that parks inconsiderately and has taken down the registration number. They will be reporting it to the authorities if this does not stop.
