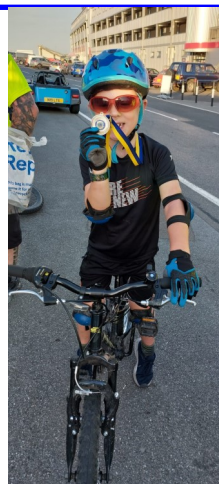


Well done Molly-Rose from year 5 who completed her first Ice Skating

Well done Ethan from year 3 who completed a charity bike ride around Brands Hatch race circuit. He did 7 laps and got a medal.

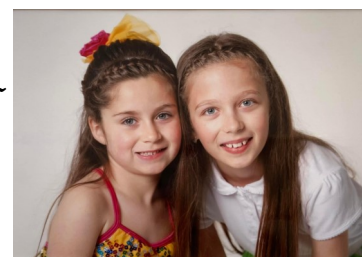


Congratulations Lachlan from year 3 for getting the student of the month trophy at Karate.

Well done Lisa from year 5 who went to dance classes at the JAG studio in the summer, she had

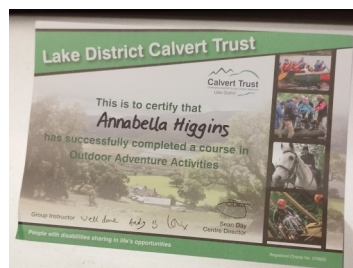


previously been dancing in Ukraine for 5 years. Lisa also attends the

Well done Mia from year 4 who graduated to Orange belt in Karate.



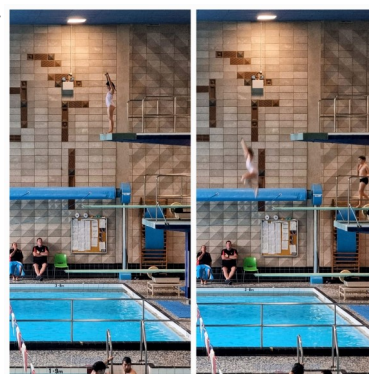
Congratulations Isla from year 6 who took part in the Memory Walk for Alzheimer's and Dementia. She raised a massive £370 for this amazing charity.
