Assessment


Pupil learning and progression will be assessed throughout the term, with each language skill (speaking, listening, reading and writing) being assessed thoroughly at the end of the term.

Impact- How will we know we achieved our aims?





Children are engaged and excited to share their knowledge inside and out of lessons.



Children's knowledge is deepened and they have acquired a range of knowledge from different units which they can transition between.



Children will use their knowledge and materials to be able to perform well in assessment tasks e.g. writing, speaking, reading or listening.



Children will have a good knowledge of and be able to recall essential grammar, utilising this in their writing.



All pupils will have the opportunity to perform, present and share their knowledge aloud.



Pupils communication skills are strengthened and they are able to identify similarities between a range of languages.



Children take pride in their learning and are able to access conversations in another language, widening their opportunities.
