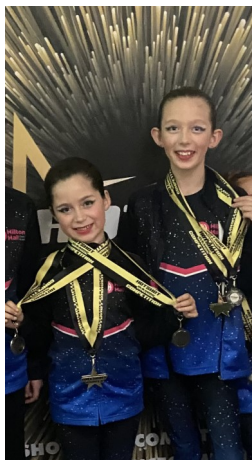


SPORTING NEWS AT BRUNSWICK HOUSE

swimming badge. He went straight from 50 metres to 200 metres. What a great achievement!



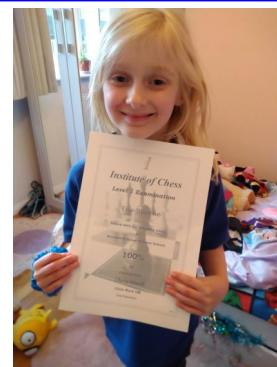
Well done Leon from Foundation Stage who has gained his second belt in Ju Jitsu.

Well done Elijah from year 6 who achieved his 2nd 'kyu black and brown belt' in Karate. He is now two grading's away from his black belt!



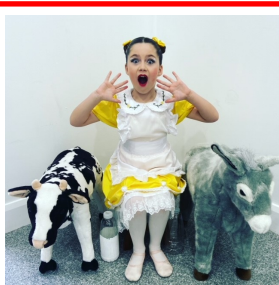
Well done Chloe from year 6 and Jess from year 2 who danced in the annual show at the Hazlitt Theatre. This was 3 shows back to back over two days.

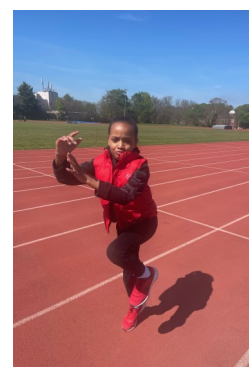
Netball
