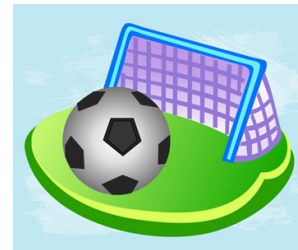


SPORTING NEWS AT BRUNSWICK HOUSE

Congratulations Darcey from year 5 who gained her 'blue' belt in her last Karate grading.



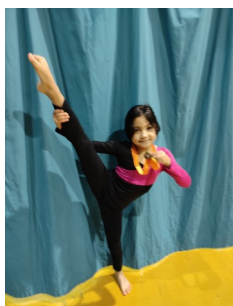
Congratulations Violette from year 4 who has been invited to join the Maidstone Swimming Club Bronze Academy.
