Here at Brunswick House Primary School, the most important responsibility of all staff is safeguarding, which is about keeping you, our children safe.

What is Safeguarding?

- Protecting you from harm and abuse.
- Making sure nothing stops you from being healthy or developing properly.
- Ensuring you grow up with safe, effective care.
- Taking action to enable you to have the best outcomes.



Always tell an adult if someone is:

- Deliberately hurting you in a **physical** way. This means hitting, kicking, shaking, throwing, burning or hurting your body in any other way.
- Saying hurtful, humiliating, distressing or uncomfortable things that affect you in an **emotional** way.
- **Neglecting** you. This includes not feeding you, not looking after you properly and not protecting you from harm.
- Touching you, or asking to see your private parts or making you touch someone else in their private parts. Showing, doing, saying or making you listen to anything **sexual**.
- **Bullying** you or cyber-bullying you.
- Showing you something **online** that makes you feel uncomfortable.
- Making you feel unsafe, hurt or uncomfortable in any other way.

Who can you tell?



You can talk to **ANY** adult that you trust. In school this might be your teacher, teaching assistant, the office staff or a Designated Safeguarding lead.



It doesn't matter who you tell, The important thing is that you tell someone.

What we will do?

We will listen to you and deal with matters in school if we are able to. If we need to take any next steps we will explain these to you. Miss Fullagar and the other DSL's will decide the best way to act. This might be helping you in school, speaking to your parents or getting support from other adults..

We will do everything we can to keep you safe.
