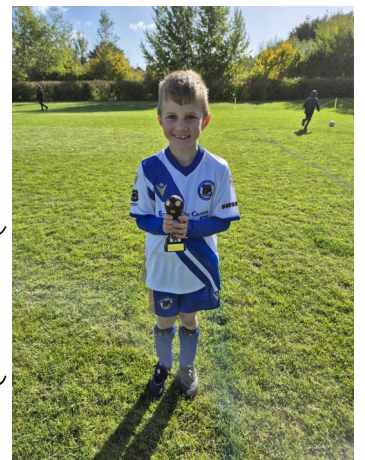


Medway Mini Rugby Festival.
