Children are bored as there is not enough to do	Zones of new equipment planned and available for children to play on and with
Not enough interaction between pupils across the school	All pupils are out playing together so siblings are able to play and children across the school.
Children do not get enough time outside as they are delayed in the hall	Pupils eat their lunch and can leave the hall as soon as they are ready, giving them maximum time for play. No delays occurring.
There is a lack of resources for children to use	Resources have been collected and are being added to continually.
There is a lack of respect for staff at all times at lunchtime	Staff are now in designated areas, and leaders are also outside. Staff follow the school values.
Petty disagreements take place constantly	Pupils are more spread out and engaged in play, so disagreements should reduce. More resources for the children to use.
Every day it takes a long time to sort disagreements when children come back into class	Pupils are more spread out and engaged in play, so disagreements should reduce. Leaders are able to talk restorative conversations straight away. More resources for the children to use.

Lots of aggression, name calling, shouting and falling out	Pupils have the opportunity to engage in play, more areas and resources have reduced this.
Lots of injuries	One First Aid station and pupils are running around in small spaces less, now there are more areas open and more resources available.
